## Congestive Heart Failure

- Acute onset of dyspnea
- Orthopnea
- Paroxysmal nocturnal dyspnea
- New/increased leg or presacral edema
- Unexpected weight gain

## Assessment

- Orientation
- Vital Signs
- Pulse Ox
- Weight
- Lung Sounds
- Cough
- Shortness of Breath (exertion or rest)
- Edema

## Treatment

- Response to meds
- Oxygen
- Intake / Output
- Mobility
- Appetite
- Elimination
- Complaints/Comfort

## Pneumonia

- Productive cough
- Functional decline increase
- Increased ADL dependence
- Reduced oral intake
- Increase lethargy
- Altered mental status
- Dyspnea

## Assessment

- Orientation
- Vital Signs
- Pulse Ox
- Lung Sounds
- Cough
- Shortness of Breath (exertion or rest)
- Oxygen Requirements
- Mobility

## Treatment

- Response to meds
- Appetite
- Elimination
- Complaints/Comfort

## COPD/ Asthma

- Wheezing
- Shortness of breath
- Increased sputum production
- Decreased oxygen saturation
- Increased oxygen demands
- Increased respiratory rate

## Assessment

- Orientation
- Vital Signs
- Pulse Ox
- Lung Sounds
- Cough
- Shortness of Breath (exertion or rest)
- Mobility

## Treatment

- Response to meds
- Oxygen
- Mobility
- Appetite
- Elimination
- Complaints/Comfort

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## Pressure Ulcer / Cellulitis

- Pain
- Warmth
- Swelling
- Increased purulence
- Increased exudate
- Fever
- Induration

## Assessment

- Orientation
- Vital Signs
- Description of Area
  - Size
  - Color
  - Drainage
  - Sensitivity
  - Movement
  - Skin integrity
  - Pain

## Treatment

- Response to treatment
  - Antibiotics
  - Ointment
  - Dressing Changes
- Complaints/Comfort

## Dehydration

- Decreased urine output
- Reduced oral intake
- Hypotension
- Orthostatic hypotension
- Abnormal lab values

## Assessment

- Orientation
- Vital Signs
- Orthostatic VS
- Weight
- Mobility
- Appetite
- Intake and Output

## Treatment

- Response to IV fluids
- Elimination
- Complaints/Comfort

## Urinary Tract Infection

- Dysuria
- Frequency
- New incontinence
- Hematuria
- CVA tenderness

## Assessment

- Orientation
- Vital Signs
- Mobility
- Appetite
- Elimination
- Intake and Output

## Treatment

- Response to antibiotics
- Elimination
- Complaints/Comfort
